1. Name and duration of the research

4. Where will we collect information from you?

Your personal data will be collected with your consent directly from you when you consent to participate in this research. Email address will be collected only if you share it with us in order to participate in the follow-up survey.

5. What personal data do we collect?

We only collect information that is strictly necessary for the purposes of this research. This data includes:

- IP address (collected only by Typeform for security purposes)
- Email address (only if you agree to provide it for the follow-up assessments)

6. Who can access your personal data?

All of your personal data is processed safely and securely in accordance with applicable legislation. We will not provide your personal information to other parties. No data gathered from the citizens of EU or EES will be transferred outside of the EU or EEA.

The data will not be processed by third parties. Typeform collect respondents' IP addresses only for security purposes.

Material in electronic format is stored on computers that are protected from unauthorised use through means such as passwords. Personal data collected through the survey (e.g. email address) will be stored for a period of two years following the survey.

7. What rights do you have as a data subject?

As a data subject you have the right to:

- withdraw your consent;
- be provided with information on the processing of your personal data;
- be provided with access to personal data that concerns you;
- demand that inaccurate data be rectified;
- demand that personal data be deleted; restrict the processing of personal data;
- object to the processing of your personal data

There will not be right to demand that personal data is deleted if data subject can not be identified accurately from the data (i.e. person has not provided their email address as a direct identifier).
